

HOW TO READ YOUR CONTRACT

You can access your contract via your district portal

- Scroll down to review the information for each of your assignments.
- If you have more than one assignment for each College and Instructional Term, Repeat the ACCEPT steps for each assignment you are accepting.

To ACCEPT an assignment, you **must** :

- **CLICK** the "I Accept this Assignment" box for *each* assignment at *each* College for *each* Instructional Term, **and**
- **SUBMIT** your accepted assignments by clicking the "Confirm and Submit All Accepted Assignments" button.

Failure to ACCEPT an assignment will be deemed to have DECLINED an assignment;

1. Your name and Campus Wide Identification Number (CWI)
2. Term and College for which the assignment is being offered
3. Course Reference Number (CRN)—number assigned to the course for registration purposes
4. Click on the icon for information associated with the course
5. Course name and identification number
6. Courses with multiple sections are assigned a section number
7. Beginning and Ending dates of the quarter (these dates also establish part---time faculty contingency status)
8. Times the class begins and ends
9. Day/s of the week the class meets
10. Indicates where the class meets (campus, building and room number)

11. Maximum number of students allowed to register for the class
12. Your step and column on the Part--Time Faculty salary schedule (Appendix C of *The Agreement*)
13. Load Factor--percentage of a full--time load that the course represents. Part--time faculty can teach up to a .67 annual load
14. Represents Schedule C Step and Column pay rate
15. Gross compensation for the course based on Step and Column placement
16. Date on which the contract was electronically issued
17. In order to be paid for the class, you must check this box and submit online
18. Date on which you electronically submitted acceptance of the assignment
